

Expectations & Code of Conduct

General Expectations of RDS+ Students

Each student is expected to behave in a responsible manner by:

- 1. Being supportive of an effective virtual learning and teaching environment.
- 2. Demonstrating courtesy and respect for others.
- 3. Being prepared for each day with the necessary supplies and being on time.
- 4. Obeying all campus and classroom rules.
- 5. Respecting all students, teachers, and volunteers.
- 6. Respecting the property of others, including RDS facilities.
- 7. Cooperating with and assisting the staff in maintaining safety, order, and discipline.
- 8. Cleaning up after themselves at the end of each day.
- 9. Reporting any illness or symptoms of illness to the teacher/staff immediately.

Behavior that is disruptive to the learning environment, physically or mentally harmful or illegal is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. Examples of this behavior include, but are not limited to 1:

- 1. Harassment
- 2. Intimidation
- 3. Bullying
- 4. Theft
- 5. Destruction and/or defacing property
- 6. Fighting
- 7. Leaving RUMC property
- 8. Disrespect to fellow students/staff
- 9. Inappropriate use of technology
- 10. Inappropriate behavior that is disruptive to the learning or safety of others
- 11. Possession or use of a weapon
